1. Introduction

Name

Email address

Username

Encrypted or hashed password credentials

Account preferences and settings

IP address and device information

Login dates, times, and security-related activity

Information you provide when contacting us

Any other information necessary to provide the website or its services

We only collect personal data that is relevant and necessary for the purposes described in this policy.

3. Why We Process Your Personal Data

We process your personal data for the following purposes:

Account creation and management

To create, maintain, authenticate, and secure your user account.

Lawful basis: Performance of a contract or taking steps at your request before entering into a contract.

Providing our services

To provide access to login-protected areas and the functionality available through our website.

Lawful basis: Performance of a contract.

Security and fraud prevention

To protect our website, users, systems, and accounts from unauthorised access, abuse, fraud, and other security threats.

Lawful basis: Legitimate interests and, where applicable, compliance with legal obligations.

Communications

To respond to enquiries, provide important service or account-related communications, and notify you about relevant changes.

Lawful basis: Performance of a contract, legitimate interests, legal obligation, or consent, depending on the communication.

Legal compliance

To comply with applicable laws, regulations, legal requests, and enforcement requirements.

Lawful basis: Legal obligation.

4. Login and Password Security

Passwords are not intended to be stored in readable plain-text form. We use appropriate technical and organisational measures designed to protect account credentials and other personal data.

You are responsible for:

Keeping your login credentials confidential.

Using a strong and unique password.

Not sharing your account with unauthorised persons.

Informing us promptly if you believe your account has been compromised.

5. Cookies and Similar Technologies

Our website may use cookies and similar technologies.

Some cookies may be strictly necessary to:

- Keep you logged in.
- Maintain your session.
- Protect against security threats.
- Remember essential preferences.

Where we use non-essential cookies, such as analytics or advertising cookies, we will obtain consent where required by applicable law.

6. How We Share Personal Data

We do not sell your personal data.

We may share personal data with trusted third parties where necessary, including:

- Hosting and cloud infrastructure providers.
- Authentication and security providers.
- Email and communication service providers.
- IT support and website maintenance providers.
- Professional advisers.
- Government authorities or law enforcement bodies where legally required.

Where third parties process personal data on our behalf, we require appropriate contractual and organisational safeguards.

7. International Transfers

If we transfer your personal data outside the United Kingdom, European Economic Area, or another jurisdiction with applicable transfer restrictions, we will use appropriate safeguards required by applicable data protection law.

These safeguards may include approved contractual clauses or another legally recognised transfer mechanism.

8. How Long We Keep Your Data

We retain personal data only for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes for which it was collected, including:

- For as long as your account remains active.

For a reasonable period after account closure where necessary for legal, security, fraud-prevention, or record-keeping purposes.
For longer periods where required by law.

When personal data is no longer required, we will delete it or anonymise it where appropriate.

9. Your Data Protection Rights

Depending on applicable law, you may have the right to:

- Request access to your personal data.
- Request correction of inaccurate or incomplete data.
- Request deletion of your personal data.
- Request restriction of processing.
- Object to certain processing.
- Request the transfer of your data to another organisation where applicable.
- Withdraw consent where processing is based on consent.
- Lodge a complaint with the relevant data protection authority.
